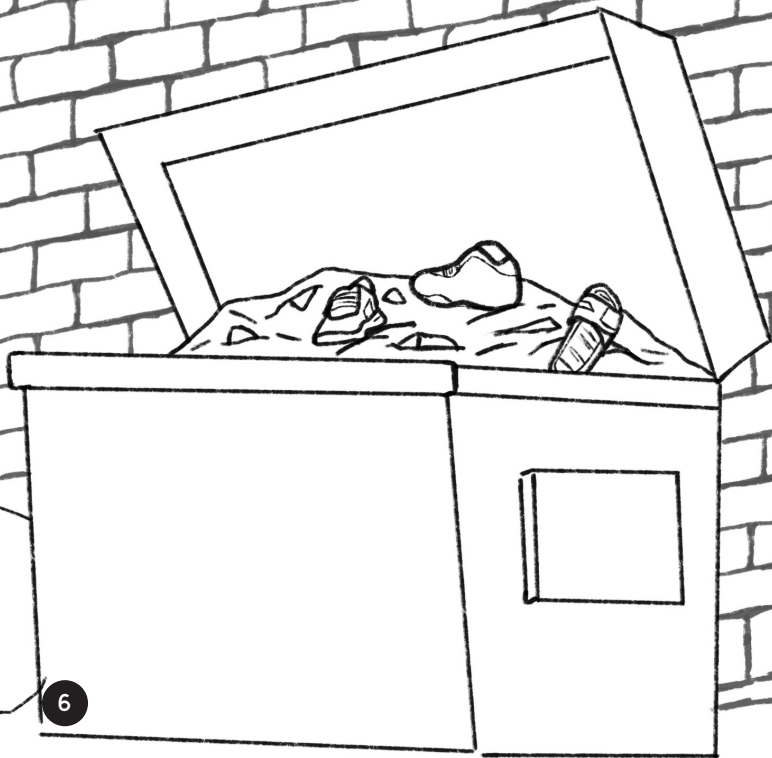
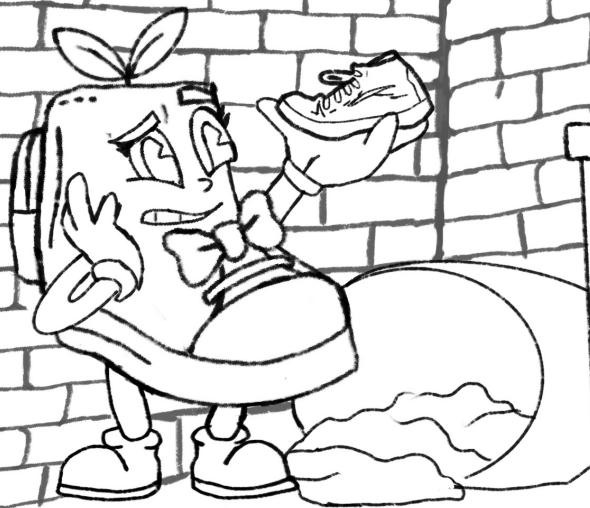
In a faraway galaxy, where sneakers could zoom,

Not just a rock, but a world-changing dream!



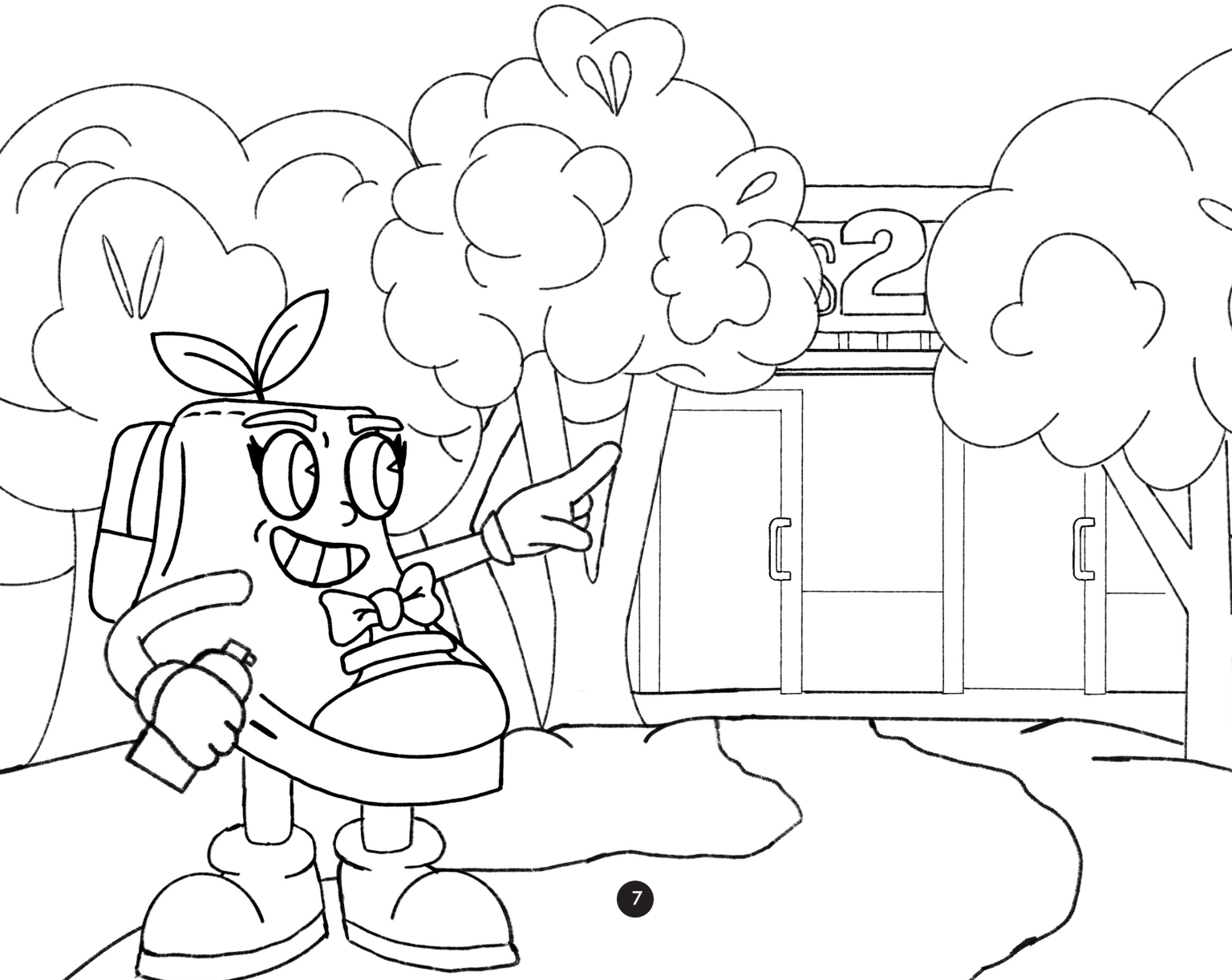
Out stepped a hero in sneakers so bold,

But people throw them out—oh, if they knew!"

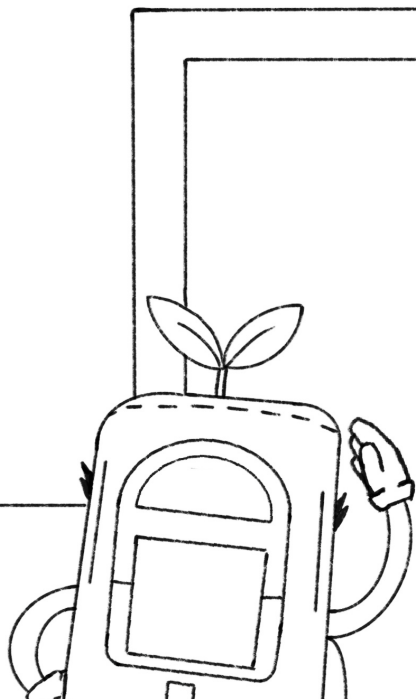


And so Sneakster was sent with a magical spray,

And spotted a logo she couldn't let slide.

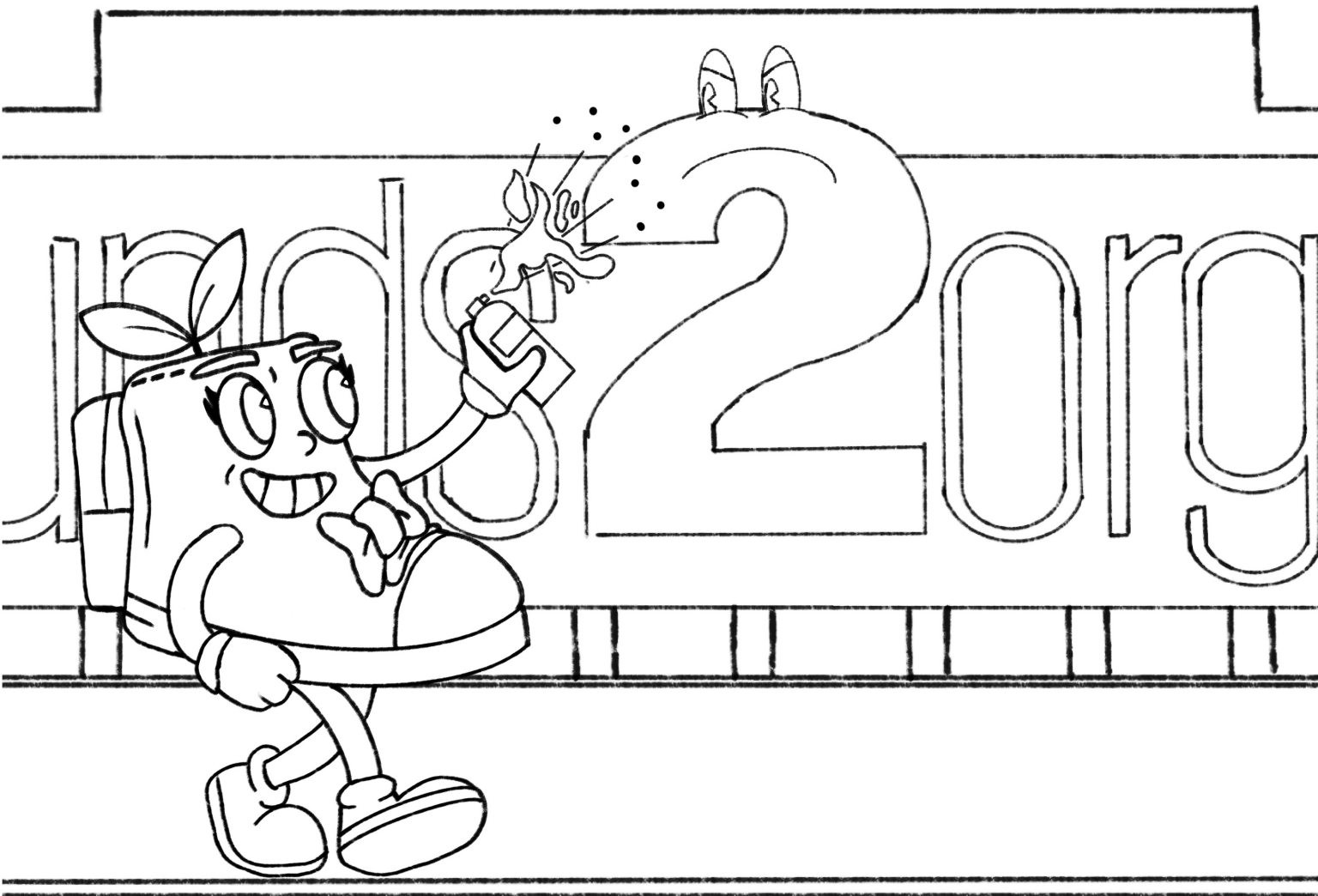


It read "Funds2Orgs," a name known far and wide—

To help causes grow while helping Earth too.

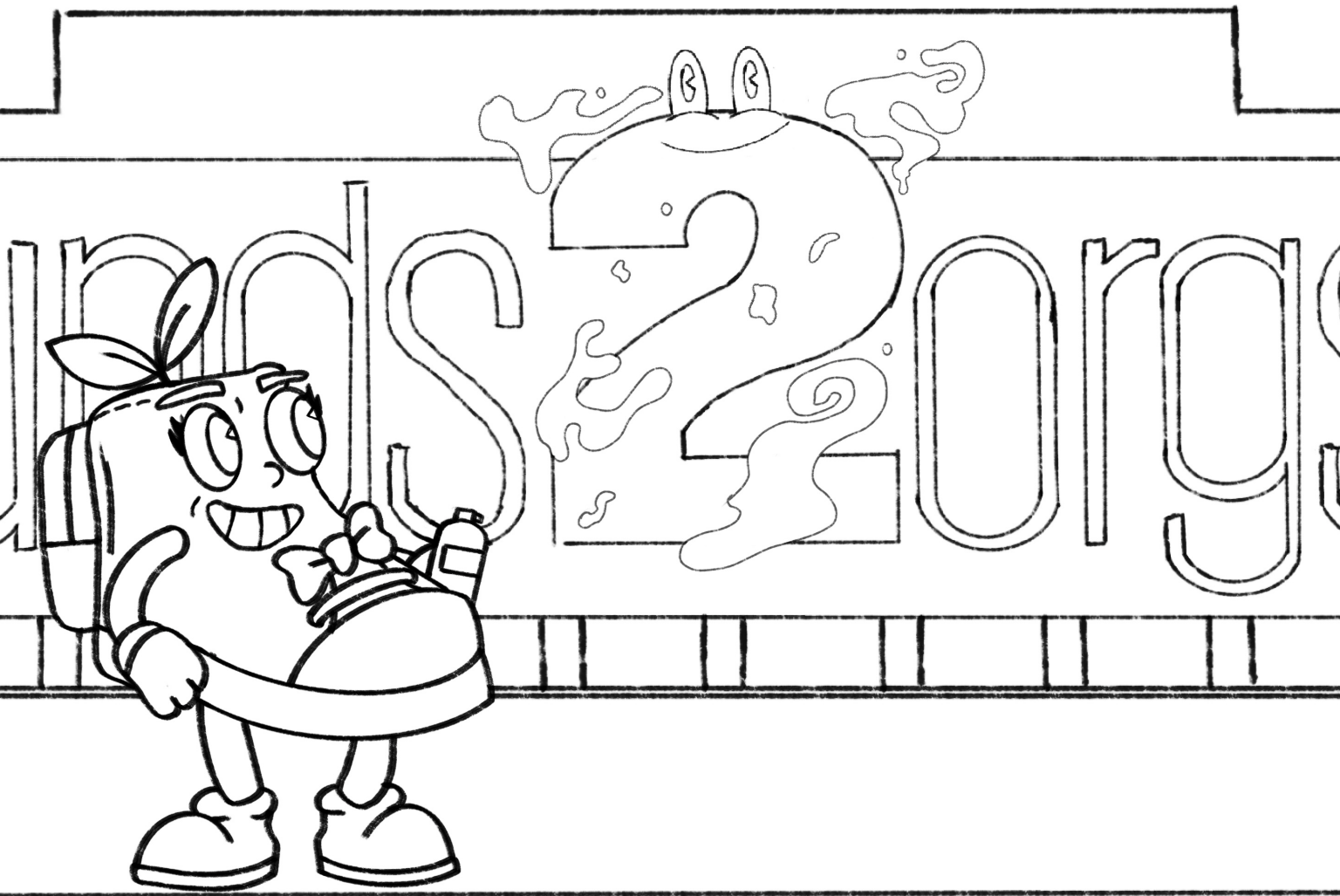

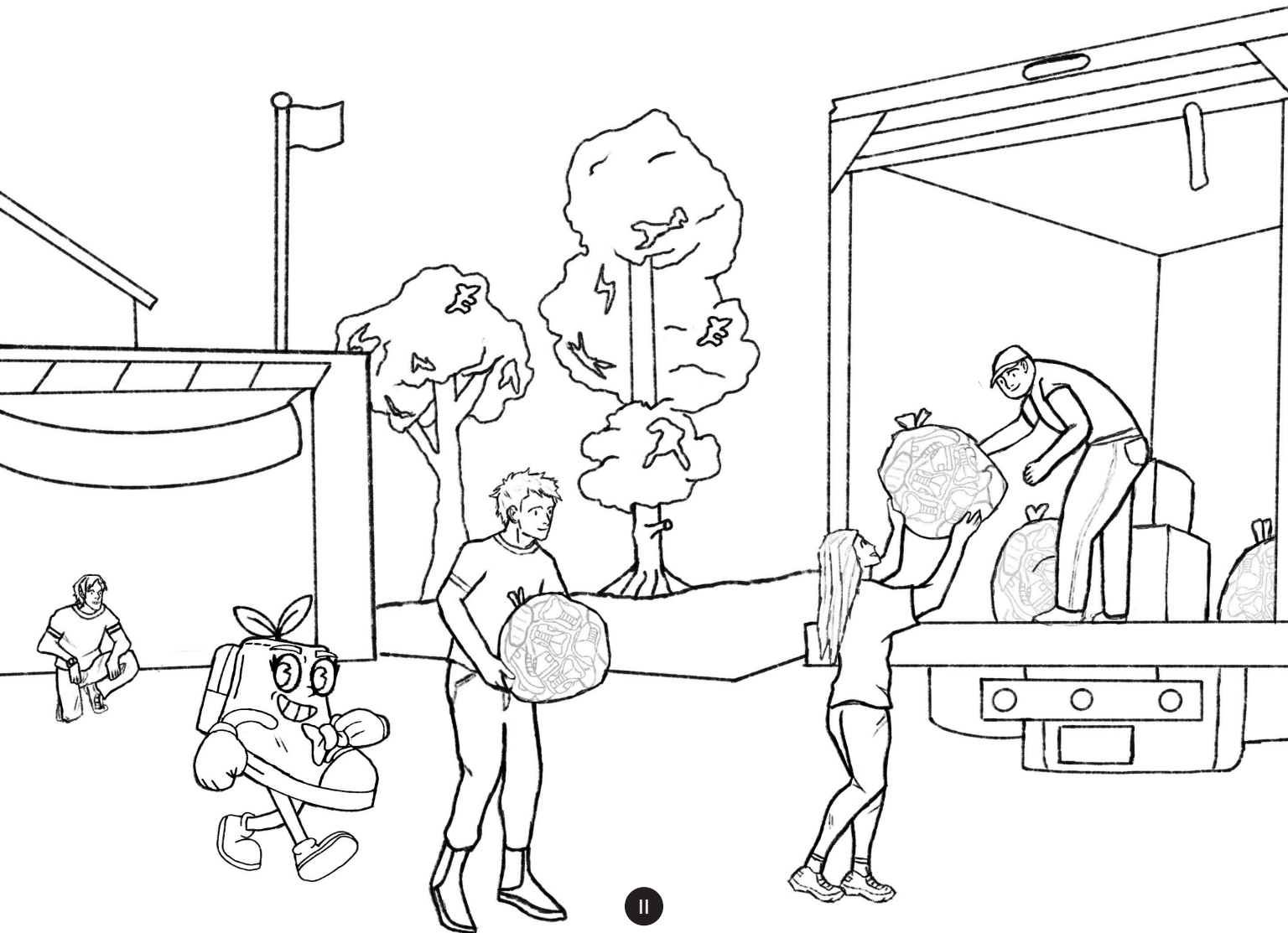
But the red "2" in the name looked angry and mean—

You help build small businesses in places with few."

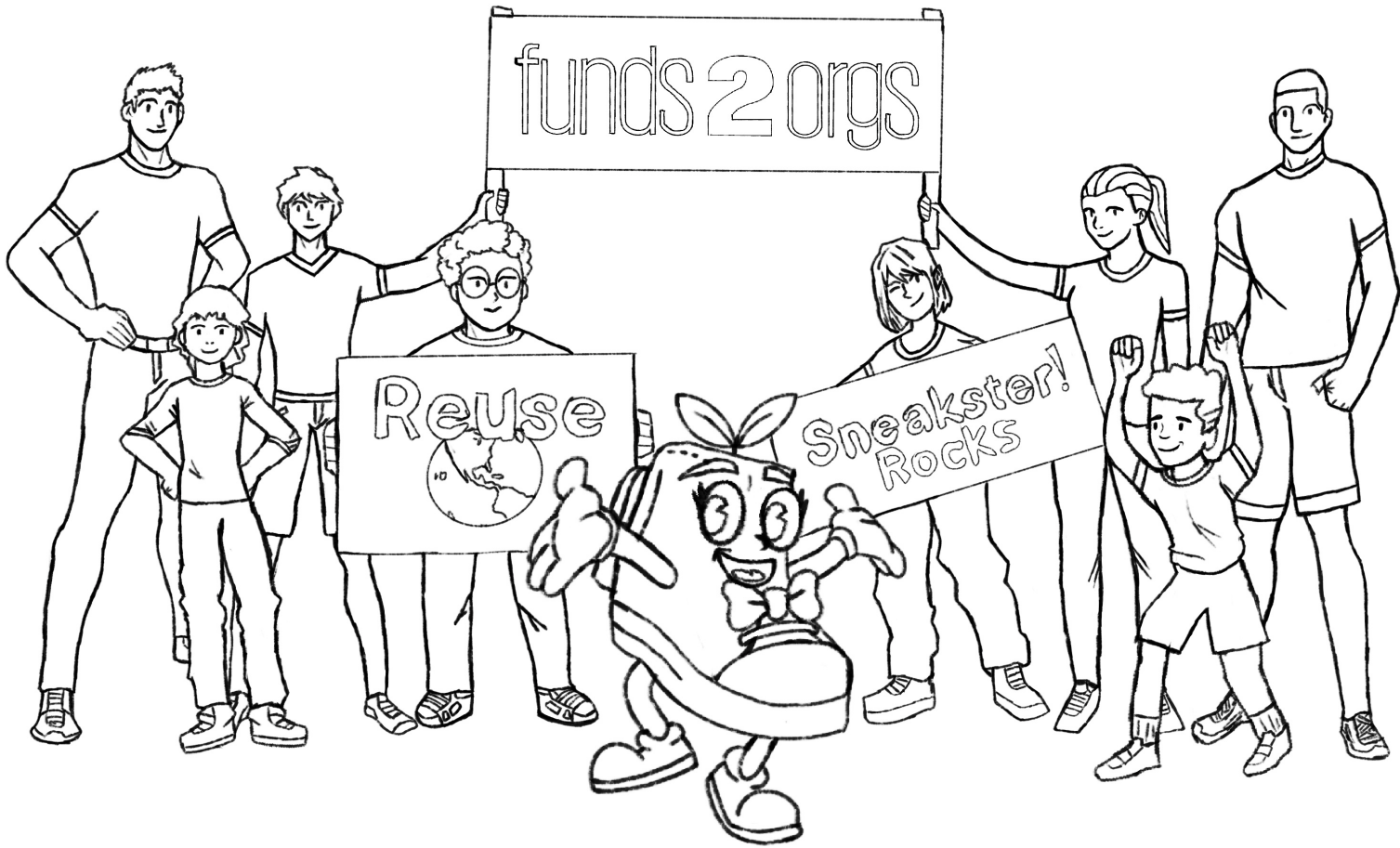


“Far across oceans, these shoes find new feet—
